Pastor John Bradshaw



John Bradshaw is the president of It Is Written, a media evangelism ministry based in Collegedale, Tennessee. His programs have been filmed on six continents and are viewed globally on It Is Written's own channel, It Is Written TV, and on numerous other channels. Pastor Bradshaw has held more than 100 evangelistic series around the world. He is married to Melissa, and they have two children.

Dr. Terry Lyndon Johnsson



Portland native, **Dr. Terry Lyndon Johnsson**, serves as mission integration executive for Adventist Health Portland. Through his work, Dr. Johnsson leads spiritual care as well as the community well-being program. He is also a board-certified chaplain.


Dr. Johnsson is active in creating unique spiritual care models for Adventist Health Portland that benefit both the health system and the city of Portland. Because of his model of "let's be friends with the community before they become patients," Dr Johnsson was invited to join the Royal Rosarians, the oldest civil group in Portland, through which he serves as a goodwill ambassador for the city.

He also founded a nonprofit high school mentoring program, Student Healthcare Leaders, to expose high school students to all aspects of the healthcare world. In February 2018, Dr. Johnsson was awarded the city's prestigious Martin Luther King Jr. Lifetime Achievement Award.

Dr. Johnsson's achievements are nothing short of a miracle, considering he was diagnosed with an extreme case of dyslexia as a young man. He was the first African American from Oregon to serve in the U.S. Air Force Presidential Honor Guard at the White House, a role he continued through three presidencies. He went on to earn two undergraduate degrees, a master's degree, and a doctorate at Wesley Theological Seminary. His full story can be found in his books, *For His Honor* and *Aim High*.

Terry has traveled and spoken to thousands of young people in all 50 U.S. states and 67 countries, including the former USSR, sharing fascinating stories of hope, healing, and inspiration.

Nurse's Station – Located in the Administration Building

Vehicles

For safety, the speed limit is 10 mph. Park only in designated areas and avoid blocking traffic. Do not drive on sidewalks and walking paths. Please hang the green tag given to you at registration on your vehicle's rearview mirror.

Bicycles

Bicycles, skateboards, or rollerblades are allowed on bike trails around campus as long as you wear a helmet. **Biking on sidewalks, through parking lots, and after dark is prohibited.**

Pets

Pets on campus must be kept on a leash or in a crate and are not allowed in any campus building, including both dorms, Administration building, and gymnasium. Please be sure to clean up after your dog.
